A dispatch from Toledo, Ohio, dated June 11, says: A remarkable case has just been brought to light in this city. Hugh McIntyre, a young Irishman, arrantly died, and his remains were placed temporarily in a vault at Detroit. Eight days after an uncle visited the vault with the intention of removing the body to the cemetery, and was horrified to see the young man sitting up in his coffin, the glass of which was broken. Young McIntyre was very weak and pale; his hands were lacerated and bleeding, but he was still alive. He was at once removed. His wife was terribly frightened at his appearance, after having mourned him as dead.
