There arrived here from Indian Territory yesterday morning seven Modoc Indians—five bucks and two squaws: P McCarty, Charley Miller, Jim Long, Samuel Clinton, David Miller, Mrs Clinton and Miss R A Tober, who had received permission from the government to leave Quapavo agency, Indian Territory, and return to California and the Klamath reservation. They went up to Redding by the 1:30 a m train, en route to their destination. They say that the Modocs have received considerable education and improved in some respects during their residence in the place of exile, but they have failed in health and dwindled in numbers, until now but ninety of them remains.—Sacramento Record-Union.
