

A decision has been rendered by Acting Land Commissioner Stockinger wherein it is held that the occupation of land by an Indian, claiming it as a homestead in Washington Territory prior to the filing of the map by the railroad company, was such a claim as excepted it from the railroad grant. This decision virtually decides a large number of similar cases in Oregon.

Connecticut has four tickets in the field this year. The law of the State requires that a candidate shall receive a majority of all the votes cast in order to be elected. Two years ago the Democratic candidate for Governor received a plurality but not a majority of all the votes cast, which threw the selection upon the Legislature, which being Republican selected the Republican candidate, says the News.

For the past year the imports of gold have exceeded the exports by about fifteen millions of dollars, while the exports of silver have exceeded the imports by about fifteen million dollars; which state of facts controverts the idea that the existing coinage law will drain the country of gold and flood it with silver.
