McClellan, who some time ago struck a son of Mr. Richards' with a pitchfork, was indicted by the Benton coun-'ty grand jury for assault with a dangerous weapon. He was arraigned and plead guilty, which was all he could do. Our readers will remember that he beat the boy on the head with the pitch-fork so that pieces of skull were taken from the wound. The boy recovered, which is very fortunate for McClellan, who would otherwise have stretched home. On November 19th, Judge Bean heard some evidence about his case and sentenced frim to ten years in the penitentiary.
