The Disunited United Brethren.

The members of the United Brethren church who have long maintained a college at Philomath, Benton county, are having considerable trouble and litigation in regard to church matters and property in this and other states. According to their original church laws and discipline a person belonging to a secret society could not become a member of the church. This provision has always been a source of trouble in the church as the members were divided in regard to the matter as well as upon some other question of discipline and confession. At the general conference of the church held in December, 1889, the discipline was amended so as to admit members of secret societies into the church, and in some other minor matters. About fifteen of the 129 members of the conference objected to the change and left the conference in a body and convened another conference, claiming that they were the only true representatives of the church. This action resulted in a division, and as a result of this division lawsuits are pending in many states in regard to which of the two factions is entitled to the church property. In this state a suit is pending in Benton county in regard to the college property of the Brotherhood at Philomath. Each of the factions has instituted a suit to enjoin the other from using it, and consequently the property is in the hands of a receiver. The school has been suspended in the college buildings, but each faction has created other buildings and are conducting two different schools, both of which is claimed to be "Philomath College." There are now two sets of bishops, presiding elders and ministers. The case was tried Thursday last week on a motion to dissolve the two injunctions, before Judge Bean in chambers at Salem, and he now has the matter under advisement.
