SATURDAY, MARCH 15, 1890. Nearly Starved to Death.

While some Indians were out hunting Friday, February 28, in the mountains near the Siletz Indian reservation in Benton county they came upon two white men who had been in the mountains for forty-five days, without anything to eat save a small loaf of bread, a pound of meat, a little coffee and a few salmon which they caught along the Siletz river.

It appears that a company of trappers consisting of the following named men, Willie Forehand, J. L. Johnson, John Cushman and E. Steen, came in from the valley in December last, on the headwaters of the Siletz river, and established a camp for the purpose of trading and hunting.

While lying here they heard the baying of a dog and looking up they saw an Indian across the river, one of the party that was out hunting. They made signs and called to the Indians and tried to make him understand that they were lost and perishing from cold and hunger.

The matter was reported to Agent Buford, who had the men brought to the agency and put in the care of Mr. F. W. Stanton and his wife, under whose kind care and nursing the men are fast gaining strength and will soon be restored to health.

The names of the Indians are Henry, Bill, Moses, Laru, and Upper Farm Jakey. Those white men feel that they owe a debt of gratitude to their redskin brothers that they can never repay.
