Florence News.

The West, May 24. A large wharf and warehouse are to be built east of the Florence cemetery.

County Surveyor Collier is at work finishing up the survey in the Ten mile district which was postponed last fall.

The sport-loving people of Florence are just now spending their idle moments in catching nice large ocean perch.

There is talk of soon erecting an Odd Fellows Hall at Glenside. The idea is a good one and should not be abandoned.

Why would not the seal oil industry pay here? There are thousands of seals at the mouth of the river. A seal will produce from two to five gallons of oil and the oil sells at fifty cents per gallon.

Some very good work is being done on the old wagon road to Florence. Mr. W. Southernland has about twelve men at work and informs us that he will complete the grading in about four weeks.

Capt. John Bergman and W. F. Saffley departed this morning for Marshfield. They expect to return Tuesday with the steamer Lillian. The Lillian is said to be a handsome passenger boat and will ply between Florence and Yagins with Captain Bergman at the wheel. This news will relieve those who are waiting to come to Florence but are detained on account of the roads being impassable for a time.

A petition is being circulated and signed by everybody, requesting the commissioners to repair the road from the bridge, on Lake creek to Nesley's, and to commence operations now. The appropriation for this part of the road can be placed in the hands of John Wiseman, or some one else, and with a crew of men the labor necessary to make the road passable for present uses would shortly be done. The stage can now come to Lake creek, over that road, and the repairing of the seven miles of road spoken of, would give us wagon communication in a few days.

The unsurveyed land which lies South of Glenside will soon be surveyed by Surveyor A. R. Butolph. Its occupants may then secure titles to their homes.

County Superintendent Hutchinson, of Douglas county, was in the city the first of the week. We understand that a new school district has been formed on the Glenside side of the bay.
