

General Orders Concerning the Encampment to be Held at Eugene in June and July.

HEADQUARTERS 2d REG'T INF., O. N. G.,
Salem, Oregon, June 11, 1891.

GENERAL ORDER NO. 3.
I. An encampment of the second regiment of infantry is ordered at Eugene, June 27 to July 4, for instruction and drill. This encampment being held by authority of law, every officer and enlisted man is required to be present for duty.

II. Men enrolled after May 20 of this year, except in case of re-enlistment, will not be taken into camp, but carried on company rolls as absent without leave.

III. From this date company commanders will give special attention to, and instruct in, the following:—
First. Duties of guards and sentinels and the ceremony of guard mounting. "Kenyon's Manual of Guard Duty" is that approved "for the government of United States troops in the performance of guard duty. Every officer should possess a copy.

Second. Military courtesy; general regulations for the conduct of troops; and paragraphs 1 to 187, Reckley's Infantry Tactics. Instructions in both above numbers not to occupy not less than one hour per week till date of encampment.

Third. Care of arms and equipments. Captains will see that the arms are in thorough condition, that the barrels of equipments are bright, and waist belts and boxes thoroughly cleaned and buckled, and enforce these measures by frequent and thorough inspection.

Fourth. Captains will make a report, upon the regular morning report of each drill, and upon June 10 and 20 a report upon some form of number of men will be taken into camp.

Fifth. Officers are expected to prepare themselves for battalion drill by a careful study of that subject.

IV. Each man will furnish himself with the following:—1 comb, 1 deep tie plate, 1 cup, 1 tin, knife, fork and spoon, and 1 hair brush. In addition each man may take 1 hair brush, 1 tooth brush, 2 towels, 2 pair socks, 1 suit underclothing, 1 bed tick, 1 pair of light shoes. The dishes will be securely boxed for shipment and shipped to Eugene in advance. The remaining articles will be rolled in the blankets, which will be carried in the center and near each end, carried on right shoulder diagonally across the body, ends tied together over the left hip. No citizen's clothing will be taken into camp, and no trunks or suitcases except as hereafter noted. Each company commander will take into camp the company baggage and records, and for the security and for the transportation of personal property will be allowed one trunk. Each lieutenant will be allowed one satchel. Transportation and rations will be furnished by the state. Troops will be paid for the six days actually in camp as provided by law. By order of

Ochooco Review: Stock Inspector Dobson has completed his spring tour of inspecting the sheep country of this county, and is now inspecting 147 bands, aggregating 35,419 head, exclusive of lambs. Of these he found 46 bands affected with scab. There were a few bands owned in this county that were being ranged in other counties at the time Mr. Dobson made the inspection. So he estimates that there were 150,000 sheep belonging to residents of Crook county the 1st of May. He estimates the sale of mutton to have been 40,000 head, and that the increase this spring is 80,000 head so that after the mutton is taken out there will be 230,000 sheep left in the county. He thinks the sheep throughout the county have averaged 7½ pounds of wool, making a total of 1,415,000 pounds for this year's clip. If the sheep raisers realize 18 cents a pound for their wool, and the prospects are that they will get that much or more, the wool sales will amount to \$254,700. The mutton that has already been sold has brought in the neighborhood of \$100,000, so the cash income from the sheep business in Crook county will be something over \$350,000 this season. Dr. Dobson says the sheep raisers are generally in good spirits, and that very few of them talk of going out of the business.
