

PENDLETON.

Since returning home from Pendleton we have been asked many questions concerning the capital city of Umatilla county.

She has two manufactories that contribute greatly to her prosperity. One is a flouring mill that grinds 90,000 bushels of wheat every month in the year and employs a large force of men.

Pendleton virtually has the Union Pacific, Northern Pacific and Great Northern railroads to compete for her transportation.

The city has two excellent daily newspapers, the East Oregonian and the Tribune, and both are liberally patronized by the citizens of the place.

Some of the newspapers in another state have been bragging of a 32-year-old grandmother and sending her picture all over the country.

P. F. Morey, president of the electric company of Oregon City says the business done on the Willamette is increasing, and the tonnage passing through the locks this year has been 33 1/2 per cent larger than in any former year since he has been connected with the business.

Eugene Leigh has bought the great racer Kingston for breeding purposes at a good round sum. The admirers of the "brown whirlwind" have probably had the last opportunity of seeing him race.

Pomona, Cal., Progress: The First National bank of this place has paid out since September 1 about \$110,000 to the sugar-beet growers of China and the employees of the sugar factory.

New York, Oct. 9.—Two hundred and fifty Chinamen, who had grown rich in the laundry business in various parts of New England and the Southern states, were hauled out of the grand central station last evening in three emigrant cars on the New York Central road.

Oakland, Cal., Oct. 9.—At 6 o'clock the broad guaged local from East Oakland ran into an open switch and off a blind track into the mud flats about 1000 yards west of the station this morning.

Another Japanese War Loan. London, Oct. 10.—A dispatch to the Pall Mall Gazette from Yokohama says the Japanese government has decided to raise an internal war loan of £10,000,000, which, together with the new taxation for war purposes, will bring the resources of the government up to £28,000,000.
