FOR THE BLOOD

It will be remembered that some months ago the office at Portland was robbed of a large quantity of the blood, the theft was not apprehended at the time, but is now believed to be in custody.

Another of the gang stated that Jenny had told him about robbing a post-office near Eugene, and he is doubtless the fellow who robbed the post-office at Portland.

A few weeks after the robbery of the post-office, W. W. Cochran learned there was a reward of \$500 for the apprehension of the guilty party, and went up to Pleasant Hill to investigate the matter. He traced the matter to where he felt confident that a man giving his name as Bob Henderson, who had worked around Pleasant Hill, was the guilty party. Henderson had then gone to Cottage Grove, and Mr. Cochran went there, but could find no trace of him except that he had undoubtedly gone to California, and in that state part of the gang now in custody were caught. Mr. Cochran feels certain that the man giving his name as Henderson is the man Jenny who is in custody.

The matter is being investigated and the facts of the whole matter will probably soon be brought to light.

Francis Christman has returned from Portland and is busy erecting a new store and expects to be ready to open up again by about the 10th of June.


James M. Martin, of Cottage Grove, will start home in a few days.
