### BRYAN DATES.

Salem Journal: "The Journal is advised that Wm J Bryan of Nebraska, has accepted a date at the Ashland Chataqua July 13th.

"He will give one day to Marion county—the next day July 14—Wednesday. As Salem will probably have no Fourth of July celebration this year Bryan's date at Salem should be made the occasion of a great Silver demonstration.

"The Journal is informed Bryan will speak on bimetallism at Ashland and probably no other topic will satisfy the people here. When Bryan was at Salem a year ago last state fair, the managers of the state fair did not exert themselves to let the crowds get near Bryan. If he comes to Salem again there is no powers on earth can keep the people from hearing him. People will come hundred of miles to hear Wm Jennings—the young champion of the west."

Crook county has had an expensive overcoat trial. A man was arrested charged with stealing that outer garment and after several months his trial and acquittal took place. A bill of several hundreds of dollars of costs is left for tax payers to settle.
