Tax Collections.

During the week ended May 11,
there was turned over to the county
treasurer by the sheriff \$19,603.36, tax
money, making a total collected to
date of \$82,679.62. The total amount
to be collected is \$129,283.77, leaving
yet uncollected \$46,604.15. It has been
announced that the books would be
closed May 15, but the large amount

The U. S. Grand Jury So Reports in the
T. J. Craig Case.

Craig Will Return Tonight.

A dispatch received this afternoon
is as follows:

PORTLAND, May 12, 3 p. m.—The
United States grand jury in the T. J.
Craig case reported this afternoon
"Not a true bill." Craig will return
tonight to Eugene.

It will be remembered that Craig
was arrested some time since on the
charge of being a defaulter as post-
master of the Eugene office to the
amount of about \$2,100 which his
bondsmen paid.

Mr Craig claimed that the defala-
cation was the result of using the money
to pay private indebtedness created be-
fore his appointment as postmaster.
It is evident the grand jury took this
view of the case.
