Weather Indications for the Next Ten Days.

Foster's last bulletin gave forecasts of the storm wave to cross the continent from 21st to 25th, and he says the next will reach the Pacific coast about 26th, cross the west of Rockies country by close of 27th, great central valleys 28th to 30th, Eastern states 31st.

Warm wave will cross the west of Rockies country about 26th, great central valleys 28th, Eastern states 30th. Cool wave will cross the west of Rockies country about 29th, great central valleys 31st, Eastern states June 2d.

Temperature of the week ending May 22d will be below normal in Texas, about the upper lakes and in the north Atlantic states at the north of Washington. In all other districts the temperature of the week will be about normal.

Rainfall of the week will be about normal in Texas, lower Mississippi valley and about the upper lakes. In other districts the rainfall will be deficient.
