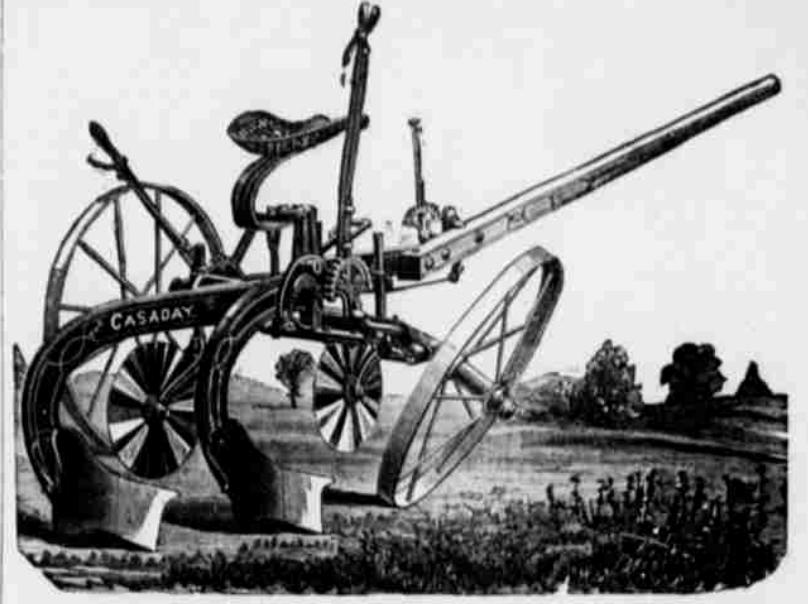

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 15. FALL FAIR NOTES. Southern Oregon District and Salem State Fair. Extensive preparations are being made for the fourth annual exhibit of the First Southern Oregon District Agricultural Society, which will open at the new fair grounds at Medford, Tuesday, September 21, and will continue five days. In years past this fair has been held at Central Point, but on the completion of the new grounds near Medford the management of the agricultural society decided to hold the fair there this fall.

W H Savage, superintendent of the state fair pavilion, at Salem, is now rearranging the interior of the pavilion and assigning space to exhibitors.
