The Law of Newspapers.

1. Subscribers who do not give express notice to the contrary are considered as wishing to continue their subscriptions. 2. If any subscribers order the discontin-

uance of their newspapers, the publisher may continue to send them until all arrear-3. If subscribers neglect or refuse to take

their newspapers from the offices to which they are directed, the law holds them responsible until they have settled the bills, and ordered them discontinued. 4. If subscribers remove to other places without informing the publisher, and the

newspapers are sent to the former direction, they are held responsible. 5. The courts have decided that refusing to take newspapers from the office, or removing and leaving them uncalled for, is prima facie evidence of intentional fraud.

6. The postmaster who neglects to give the legal notice of the neglect of a person to take from the office the newspapers ad-dressed to him, is liable to the publisher for the subscription price.

Land Warrants can be obtained for services rendered before 1855, but not for services in the late war. Pensions for late war and 1812 THOMAS' obtained and increased when allowed for less than disability warrants, but no pensions are allowed to Mexican and Florida war soldiers. 


