ART. 10. The Master shal preside at the meetings of the Council, sign all
rders on the Treasurer, and do such other things as usually devolve upon
this office.
Arr. 11 . The Overseer shall preside in the absence of the Master.
Ar. 12. The Seecretary shal kep
Tn an accurate record of the proceeding of
this Council, and the account with the members; ; shall draw and countersign
all orders on the Treasurer, and have
ti shers his books made at any time for inspec
tion by the Trustees or any member of
Council when ordered to do so by the
