ages are paid. 3. If subscribers neglect or refuse to take their newspapers from the offices to which they are directed, the law holds them responsible until they have settled the bills, and ordered them discontinued. 4. If subscribers remove to other places

without informing the publisher, and the newspapers are sent to the former direction, they are held responsible. 5. The courts have decided that refusing to take newspapers from the office, or re-moving and leaving them uncalled for, is prima facie evidence of intentional fraud. 6. 


