At Schockoe Hill Cemetery I saw the tomb of Chief Justice Marshall. It is of plain marble and stands three feet high, perhaps, and the slab which FANCY GOODS, covers the remains of America's greatest jurist bears the following simple inscription, written, all except the date of his death, by his own hand: JOHN MARSHALL, READY-MADE CLOTHING,

Son of Thomas and Mary Marshall, was born the 25th of September, 1755. Intermarried with Mary Willis Ambler the can belle of the present day. The re-3d of January, 1783. Departed this Life the 6th of July, 1835.

In the same burial ground, and near the tomb of Chief Justice Marshall, lie the remains of John Minor Botts, the great apostle of the Whig party, and by his side was that of his son, Lient. Botts, who was killed in the Mexican war in 1847.
