CLEVELAND INAUGURATED

An Immense Crowd! THE PRESIDENT'S CABINET. Special Dispatch to the Times.

WASHINGTON, March 5, 1885. The inauguration of President Cleveland at Washington since the war, and the ceremony were not so grand and brilliant.

President Cleveland sent the following nominations to the senate this afternoon, which were confirmed:

For Secretary of State, Thos. F. Bayard of Delaware; Secretary of the Treasury, Daniel Manning of New York; Secretary of War, Wm. Endicott of Massachusetts; Secretary of the Navy, W. Whitney of New York; Secretary of the Interior, L. Q. C. Lamar of Mississippi; Postmaster General, William F. Vilas of Wisconsin; Attorney General, A. H. Garland of Arkansas. All are Democrats.
