SIDETRACK AT CENTRAL POINT. The Railroad Bill and Receiver Koenig's Letter. An Act to Facilitate the Transportation of Freight.

Be it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon: SECTION 1. That whenever a warehouse shall be built on the line of any railroad in this State, with sidetrack and track laid down, without expense to said railroad company...

SECTION 2. That if any such railroad company shall fail or refuse to comply with the provisions of this act, the person injured by such failure or refusal shall be entitled to recover against said railroad company in any court having jurisdiction, a penalty of two hundred and fifty dollars for each week during which such neglect, failure or refusal shall continue...

SECTION 3. That it shall be the duty of the district attorney, on application of any citizen of the United States, to institute a civil suit in the proper United States district or circuit court, or territorial district court, in the name of the United States, and against the parties named or described who shall be in violation of the provisions of this act, and against the parties named or described who shall be in violation of the provisions of this act...

That no person, by threats, intimidation, or by any force, shall interfere with or obstruct, or attempt to interfere with or obstruct, any person in the exercise of his or her rights under the provisions of this act, and any person who shall do so shall be liable to a civil suit in the proper United States district or circuit court, or territorial district court, in the name of the United States, and against the parties named or described who shall be in violation of the provisions of this act...
