## A Bloody Assault.

One Being Brown has been in southern Oregon for the purpose of securing for committing an assault upon Ransome, the man who shot his son in New Year's night. It seems that Being and a young man had a fight at a party a short time ago, when the young man was beaten. He left the premises, and it was thought he was home. However, it only went to another house from the first, the party was proceeding, and in the dark lay waiting for his late assailant after having paid his bill.

He was not in ambush long before a person whom he supposed to be his enemy rushed to hit him on the head and fled. The injured man was soon discovered and appealed to the police for assistance. A witness to the previous affair, who was sent to see him recovered his son, and L. C. Williams, Sheriff of Jackson county, issued a warrant for Being's arrest, but finding nothing in the house, he left without serving the sheriff's office yesterday, and Mr. Billsey has gone since.

## A Terrible Accident.

W. C. Brown, Jr., third son of Geo. Brown, a merchant of Eagle Point, was the victim of a most terrible accident, which has resulted fatally. It seems that he was hunting for ducks in J. J. Foy's field near the river, when his shotgun accidentally went off. The charge struck and exploded off the powder horn, and the bullet passed through his body, severing the spinal column, and totally demolished the bone pieces which were driven into his thigh. The wound was so severe that he was unable to move. Although he cried for help, it was several hours before he was discovered. Mr. G. C. Grayson, who was taking him home, Medical aid was immediately given, but it proved to be too late, and he died a few moments later.
