WOMAN AND FASHION.

A Smart Promenade Toilet—The Flounced Skirt—A Parisian Homespun Costume.

The small promenade toilet portrayed in the sketch is of gray cloth, with the plaited skirt bordered throughout with stitching and opened slightly at the feet on a petticoat of white cloth enriched with lines of silver braid knotted in the center.

The jacket takes the form of a round-bolero bordered with stitching and is filled in by a long, wide vest of white cloth ornamented with lines of silver braid knotted in the center and

turned back at the neck in two revers, which are faced with chinchilla fur. The high collar of gray cloth is bordered with stitching and faced with chinchilla fur. The sleeves widen below the elbows and terminate a few inches above the wrists, where they are trimmed with white cloth cuffs striped with silver braid, while the full undersleeves of white cloth are gathered into a deep cuff of the same enriched with stitching.—Philadelphia Ledger.

The Flounced Skirt.

In spite of the fact that the long, plain skirts are more graceful and becoming to the generality of women the flounced skirt is coming more and more into fashion, and some of the newest gowns display this style in its various renderings, says the New York Evening Telegram. Made of lace, net or any light material, a flounced skirt is not by any means ugly, indeed in many instances is most attractive, but as every fashion suffers by imitation this one must needs be made, or rather caricatured, in cloth and heavy fabrics. Three or four flounces are considered the correct number when the lighter materials are employed; when cloth is used two are all sufficient, and these two arranged to form an overskirt effect, trimmed with a plaiting of silk. Fortunately the art of skirt cutting and hanging has progressed marvelously since the old days of flounced skirts, and with the close fitted silk drop skirt the flounces can be so adapted that they do not give the dreaded size to the figure. When it is a flounced cloth skirt, the overskirt finished with the plaiting is separate from the cloth skirt, and only the lower flounce of a half yard in depth, also finished with the plaiting, is sewed into the silk underskirt.

A Parisian Costume.

The costume represented is of poppy colored homespun. The bolero and skirt are strapped with stitched bands.

The skirt is trimmed with a wide plaited flounce, and the waistband is of black panne.—Paris Herald.

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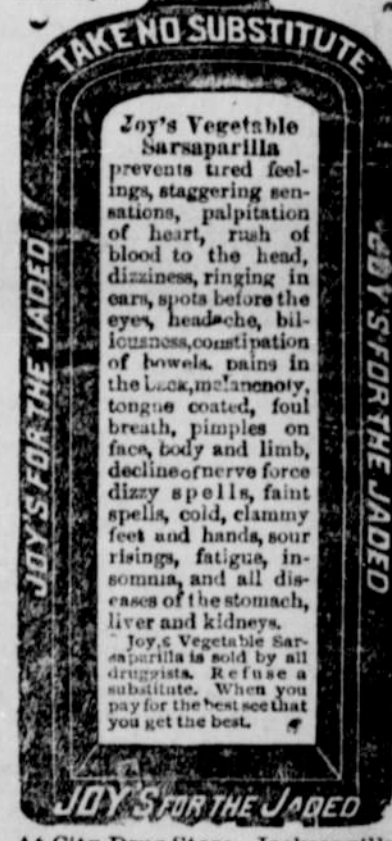
