Obtaining a U. S. Mining Patent.

A United States patent for mineral POPULARITY GAUGED BY NO PARTICU-land is obtained as follows: The claimant, having complied with all legal requirements, may file in the proper land office an application for a patent, under oath, showing such compliance, together with a plat and field notes of the claim or claims in common, made by or under the direction of the U.S. Surveyor-General, accurately showing the boundaries of the claim or claims, distinctly marked by monuments on the ground, and post a copy of such plat together with a notice of such applica-tion for a patent, in a conspicuous place on the land embraced in such plat, pre-vious to the filing of the application for a patent, and file an affidavit of at least The U.
