

#### BREVITIES.

Russian detectives have been told off to watch Russian students studying in Germany for the purpose of ascertaining whether they have had anything to do with fomenting the disturbances in Russia. German students in Berlin have been molested by the detectives, who have followed them into houses and cafes and questioned them.

Consul Mahin of Reichenberg says that, according to a report from Brussels, a Belgian engineer by the name of Toblansky has discovered a method by which smoke can be turned into light. In operating his device the inventor collects the smoke from any kind of a fire and forces it into a receiver. It is a brilliant light results.

The Salvation Army commander of land in Colorado, to which has lately been added 1,000 more, and the task of colonizing great farms in the west with the surplus poor of the cities is being prosecuted with great earnestness and with great success as well.
