Discussing the present condition of iron and steel, the Iron Age says that nothing has occurred to indicate any danger of an early subsidence of the great activity which characterizes the iron and steel trades. Not only are more iron and steel now being made and consumed in the United States than at any previous time in the history of this or any other country, but members of the trade are beginning to prophesy a still larger business the coming year.

There has been great mortality among hogs in Tehama and adjoining counties in California, from hog cholera, and as "an ounce of prevention is worth a pound of cure," the experience of a well-known hog raiser, living near Red Bluff, is entitled to careful consideration. He says: "My hogs are fed soft coal almost daily through the summer, and about all they will eat, which would be surprising to some farmers who never feed it, in the amount a hog will eat. Growing pigs and shoats like a ration of coal as regularly as they do of corn, judging from the avidity with which they take it. In winter I do not think it necessary to feed it so liberally, yet would fear no harm in supplying them with all they eat at all times of the year. My herds will average upward of 125 head of all ages for the year, and I calculate that no less number of bushels of coal slack will justify their needs. With a daily supply of coal, fresh water, a balanced ration and good sanitary surroundings, there is little danger of disease affecting them seriously."
