Rev. F. G. Strange will hold services at the Presbyterian church in Phoenix Sunday morning and evening.

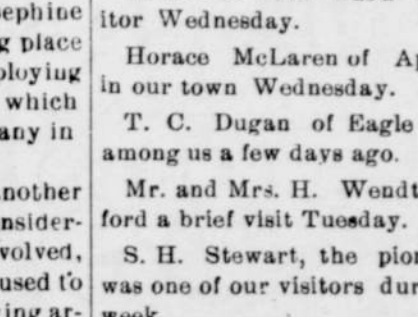
Mr. Lyden, manager of Hooligan's restaurant, has gone to Yoncalita, Douglas county, where he may spend the summer.
