SENATOR DOUGLAS'S PLATFORM. The following sentiments and principles, says the Richmond South, Mr. Douglas has avowed in his speeches:

1. Judge Douglas affirms the original and essential inferiority of the negro. 2. He denies that the negro was intended to be embraced within the abstractations of the Declaration of Independence, and asserts that right freedom and equal rights were predicated only of the dominant race of white men.

3. He denies the privileges of citizenship to the negro. 4. He affirms the compatibility of a confederacy of free and slave States, and the possibility of their harmonious co-existence under a common Constitution.

5. He affirms the absolute sovereignty of the State in respect to their domestic institutions, and denies the authority of the Federal Government to discriminate against the interests of slavery.

6. He inculcates a policy of non-interference as between the free and slaveholding States, as between the latter and the Federal Government.
