For the Sentinel. Bees. Messrs. Editors:—According to request, I will give you an account of the dividing or colonizing system of bees, in place of the natural mode of swarming.

Mr. Longstroth was the first, I believe, to introduce the system successfully; lately, Mr. J. S. Harrison, of Sacramento City, California, has made a valuable improvement in the raising of queens, for which he has obtained a patent.

In order to divide bees, it is necessary to have a moveable comb frame hive, that combs can be removed and fit any of the hives. I use the Harrison hive, as I think it the best I have seen—managed my bees this season on his system and am well pleased with the plan.

The advantages of the dividing system are: 1st. It saves time watching for swarms. 2d. Some will not swarm during the season. 3d. Others will come out and run off (or weeds).

The advantages of the Harrison hive are: 1st. They have moveable frames for dividing. 2d. They have moveable frames for surplus honey, which places it in small packages ready for market.
