1st. Statements and statistics in relation to the productiveness and character of the soil, as tried in the cultivation of wheat, oats, barley, etc.

2d. Statements and statistics with regard to the increase and cost of raising horses, cattle, sheep and hogs.

3d. Statements and statistics in relation to the costs and expenses of cultivating field crops, of the different kinds and the average price received for the same, by the farmer, and where sold.

4th. The average amount of land actually cultivated by the farmers generally.

5th. Statistics and statements with regard to mines of the precious metals, copper, iron, lead, tin, coal, and deposits of fire-clay, pottery-clay, hydraulic cement, and quarries of marble, slate, limestone, and building stone.

6th. Statements with regard to the distribution of living springs of pure water, running streams, sulphur, soda, and other mineral water, springs or deposits of petroleum (commonly known as rock oil or sea-oil), the regularity and character of the climate, and the general health.

In addition to the information on the above named subjects, correspondents are requested to state any other matter that would be useful in forming a correct opinion of the natural wealth and resources of Oregon.
