TABLE OF STAMP DUTIES [As amended by Act of June 16, 1864.] Observations on Stamp Duties. It is not lawful to record an unstamped or improperly stamped instrument, document or paper, and if recorded, such record shall be void, and shall not be used in evidence.

Legal documents, writ or other original process, commenced in any court of law or equity . . . Where amount claimed in a writ issued in a court not of record is \$100 or over . . .

Bank checks, drafts, orders, etc., at sight or on demand, for all sums of money exceeding \$10 . . . Bills of Exchange, (foreign) drawn in bills of three or more, for every bill of each set, where the sum does not exceed \$100 or its equivalent in foreign currency . . .

Patent Medicines, Bitters, Perfumery, Cosmetics, etc., on each package retailed at not over 25 cents from 25 to 50 cents . . . For every additional \$100 or fraction thereof . . .

Probate of will, or letters of administration, where the value of both real and personal estate does not exceed 2,000 dollars . . . For every additional 1,000 dollars or fraction thereof . . .

Release, discharge, and satisfaction of mortgage . . . For every additional \$100 or fraction thereof . . .
