**Enthusiastic Meeting of the Albany Grant Club—The Hall Crowded—"The New Nation."**

Last Saturday evening was the occasion of another outpouring of national feeling by the loyal citizens of Albany and vicinity. By request of the Grant Club, CALVIN B. McDONALD Editor of the *Unionist*, had consented to be present on that evening, to deliver a lecture upon "The New Nation." The Club made every preparation for the reception of a large audience, as also securing the adjuncts of both instrumental and vocal music. The Albany Brass Band played a number of national airs while the audience were convening; and preceeding the lecture, the Harmonic Quartette Glee Club—accompanied on the melodeon, whereat a beautiful young lady presided—sang a patriotic song.

The President of the Club, E. F. RUSSELL, Esq., then came forward and introduced Mr. McDONALD to the audience, by whom he was received with enthusiasm. The lecturer opened his subject by passing before the mind a panoramic view of our national history from the landing of the Pilgrims, the settlement of Jamestown, and the pall of slavery covering the fairest portion of the land, to the point where the "sum of all villainies" made open war upon civilization. It is impossible here to convey to the reader the word-pictures which the fervid and classic sentences of the lecture presented; history, poetry, and political philosophy all contributed to the theme.

We were next led to the battle-fields and prison-pens of the South; to the desolate hearths and tears throughout the loyal North and West; the assassination of our President by instrumentality and connivance of rebel sympathizers everywhere; treason now in the Executive office; and the duty of the hour. Here every word seemed a flash of lightning wielded by the Genius of Liberty herself. The audience were divided between being impassionately still to catch the slightest tones of the speaker, and the alternately bursting forth of enraptured applause accompanied by the waving of a hundred handkerchiefs by the loyal ladies present. The Ophidian party has received such a scathing by all that is classic in thought and invective, as few but Milton has known how to embody before. Those of them present began a leaving; and from what was dining in their ears, we feel assured that their dreams led along lurid cliffs and dismal deeps, and if they are conscientious, their slumbers will not be disturbed for a month.

The "new nation" is now great, strong and free; still her patriotic sons have a further conflict with the giant Wrong next fall; but under the leadership of him that took Richmond, we will march to victory, and the results and ideas secured by our four years' conflict will be secured to ourselves and posterity forever.

Mr. McDONALD concluded amidst a perfect ovation; and here we affirm that for poetic imagery, patriotic fervor, clothed "thoughts that breathe and words that burn," this lecture is equal to any production upon the same subject prepared by an American pen. There were nearly five hundred persons present, about one-fourth of whom were ladies.
