ALL CONVALESCENT.—No cases of small-pox have appeared at Yreka, and the survivors of the Castro family at Hawkinsville are all convalescent.

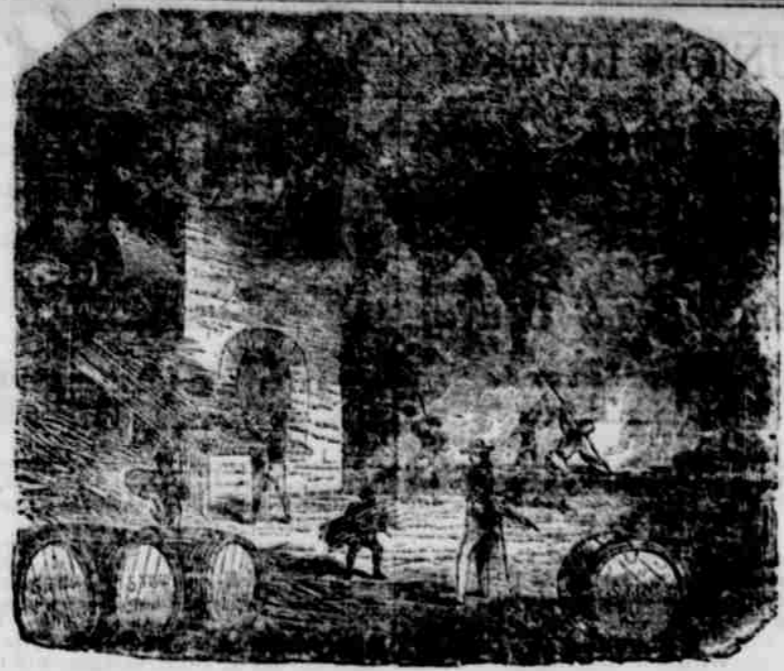
FOR MARSHAL.—Mr. John Bonham announces himself as a candidate for the Marshalship.
