M. Voit is demonstrating, by experiment, that a warm-blooded animal, a bird at least, may live after its brain has been removed. He skillfully re moves, with hooks and scalpel, the cerebral lobes from the skull of the pigeon. When the operation is concluded the poor bird bides its head under its wing and remains motionless, with closed eyes, and seems to be overcome with profound slumber. This condition lasts a few weeks, after which the victim leaves its its somnolent condition, opens its eyes, and even attempts to fly. It avoids obstacles, shops the hand that would seize it, and appears to enjoy in full force the faculties of hearing and seeing. Theoceforth the pigeons without brains cannot be distinguished from those with brains, except by their entire forgetfulness of the means of securing nourishment. They would die of hunger in a heap of grain, and it is necessary to introduce tood into their beak and stomach by the aid of a small rod. They coo, boldly come and go, and se in therestter to be strangers to every sentiment of fear. When once they commence walking they continue the impetus, following the same path around the somtable, and continually toking refuge inthe same corner. One of these animals deprived five months before of its ceretrai lobes, seemed to have recovered almost all of its primitive faculties. It was killed and its skull opened. In each of the hemisheres there was a litthe easity filled with liquid, while a septum maintained them seperate. The mass was composed of primitive nervous fibe, twice convoluted, and of true ganglion cells.

#### The Blood and Ment Shower Mear Los Angeles.

The telegram recently published, stating that a shower of blood, meat and hair had occurred in Los Angeles county, has set everybody to wondering about the phenomenon. We find in the Alta of August 11th the fellowing note, which seems to explain the affair entisfactorily :

Los ANGELES, August 7, 1869. Entrons ALLA The individual who telegraphed to you from this place about the shower of meat at Los Nieton in this county, on the 1st of the month, has a very elastic imagination. He covered two acres with liver, lights and blood.

Only about two bundred square feet showed traces of it; here and there spatterings of blood on the corn, and a few pieces of ment. Old Californians state that it is caused by the Califor nia vultures, which, having gorged themselves with dead horse and risen high in the air, eject it from their stom sche, outer from sickness or in battle with the engle. They have frequently been seen to do this

These birds are very large, like the South American vulture, and can take into their stomachs a vast quantity of carrion. They are very partial to dead colts, and upon the specimen brought bere for examination were seen fine hairs, evidently of the colt. 
