New Post Routes for Oregon.

In the Senate of the United States, January 10, 1870, Mr. Williams asked, and by unanimous consent obtained, leave to bring in the following bill:

A Bill to establish certain post routes in the State of Oregon.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the following be, and the same are hereby, established as post routes:

From the Dalles, by Fifteen-mile Creek, Tygh Valley, Oak Grove, Warm Spring Reservation, Willow Creek, to Upper Ochoco.

From Jacksonville, Oregon, by Link River, Lost River, Hot Springs, Goose Lake Valley, to Lake City, in Surprise valley, California.

From Salem, by Lincoln, Yena, Bethel, to Sheridan.

From Brownsville, by Crawfordville, Camp Creek, to Eugene City.

From Eugene City, by Butte Disappointment, Big Prairie, Pine Openings, Diamond Peak, Sprague's Valley, Round Grove, Drew's Valley, Goose Lake, Surprise Valley, to Winnemucca, Nevada.
