The annual election for town officers was ordered, and R. S. Dunlap, J. Roubesh, and A. Holmes, were appointed Judges of said election.

There was one plea of guilty, and a fine of \$50, to a charge of selling liquor without license. On the civil docket there was but one case; Jackson vs. Moon, appeal from a Justice's Court.
