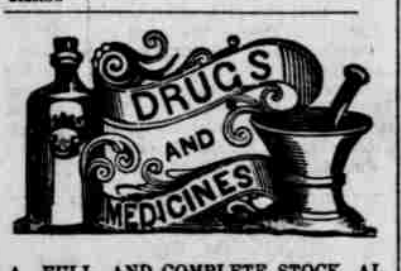

In the name of the State of Oregon: You are required to appear in said Court and answer the complaint of said plaintiff, filed against you, within ten days from the time of the service of this summons on you, if served within said county, or if served on you within any other county in this State, then within twenty days from the time of the service, or if served on you out of the State of Oregon, then it is ordered by T. H. B. Shipley, Judge of said Court, that publication be made for six weeks in the OREGON SENTINEL prior to the first Monday in February, A. D. 1871. And you are notified that, if you fail to answer said complaint as above required, the plaintiff will apply to the Court for the relief demanded therein, to-wit: for a judgment against you for the sum of one hundred and forty dollars in gold and silver coin, with interest thereon at the rate of 1 per cent per month from the 9th day of November, A.
