YEARS OF THE 17TH INST. RECEIVED. I THANK YOU FOR THE KINDLY ASSURANCE IT CONTAINS.

IN PURSUING WHAT I DEEMED THE PATH OF DUTY I EMPLOYED TO FORGET THAT I HAD ANY OTHER OR GREATER INTEREST THAN SUCH AS I POSSESSED IN COMMON WITH THE GREAT BODY OF THE PEOPLE.

CERTAINLY IT WAS WITH NO VIEW TO PERSONAL ADVANCEMENT. I WELL UNDERSTOOD THAT IN EXPOSING THE MISDEEDS OF THE MEN WHO HAD HELD POSITION SO LONG AND WERE LOOKED UPON BY MANY AS THE LEADERS OF THE PARTY, I SHOULD ARRAY AGAINST ME THE NUMEROUS BAND OF RETAINERS WHO HAD FLED FROM THE PUBLICS.

ALL WHO HAD SHARED IN THE SPOILS; ALL THAT CLASS WHO MAKE POLITICS A PROFESSION AND WHO FOR THE MOST PART LOOK WITH INDIFFERENCE UPON THE PECULIATIONS OF THOSE IN OFFICE.

IN ORDER TO RAISE AS MUCH PREJUDICE AS POSSIBLE AGAINST THE WORK OF THE COMMITTEES AND THE PROSECUTION OF THE CHARGES MADE BY THEM BEFORE THE COURTS.

FOOL WELL ASSURED THAT I HAVE DONE THE STATE SOME SERVICE. I DID IT UNDERSTANDING THAT BUT FEW WOULD APPRECIATE IT.

AND THAT LARGE NUMBERS OF MY OWN PARTY WOULD CONSIDER ME FOR IT. HENCE I FEEL NO DISAPPOINTMENT AT THE RESULT.

IT IS UNFORTUNATE FOR THE PEOPLE THAT THERE IS SO LITTLE TO STIMULATE THE AMBITIONS TO A FAITHFUL PERFORMANCE OF DUTY.

WITH THOSE WHO SEEK PERSONAL ADVANCEMENT AND PUBLIC MEN UNUSUAL OF THAT CLASS, THE INDUCEMENTS ARE ALL IN THE OPPOSITE DIRECTION.

HENCE WASTE AND CORRUPTION, NOTWITHSTANDING ALL THE OUTCRY ABOUT REFORM, CONTINUE TO INCREASE.

HUMAN VIRTUES ARE WEAK AND NEEDS ALL THE SUPPORT THAT HUMAN AID CAN GIVE.

AND WHEN ITS PRACTICE BRINGS CENSURE AND PERSECUTION INSTEAD OF PUBLIC APPROBATION, AMBITION WILL TURN ITS ATTENTION TO INTRIGUE AND THE THOUSAND DEVISIVE WAYS THAT THE UNPRINCIPLED CAN INVENT TO ADVANCE THEIR PURPOSES.

IF POLITICAL PARTIES ARE BANNED TOGETHER ON THE SAME PRINCIPAL AS HIGHWAYMEN AND FREEBOOTERS, PLEDGED TO SUPPORT EACH OTHER RIGHT OR WRONG, WITH NO HIGHER PURPOSE THAN TO SCRAMBLE FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF SAYING WHO SHALL PLUNDER THE PUBLIC, I WAS IN THE WRONG.

IF IT BE THEIR PURPOSE TO SUBSERVE THE GENERAL GOOD AND SECURE HONEST GOVERNMENT, I WAS IN THE RIGHT.

HOWEVER THIS MAY BE, THERE IS ONE CONSOLATION THAT WHEN A MAN GOES DOWN UNDER THE WEIGHT OF HIS OWN MISDEEDS, HE FALLS LIKE LUCIFER, TO RISE NO MORE; BUT THERE IS HOPE THAT HE WHO IN THE PERFORMANCE OF DUTY FALLS UNDER THE CLOUD OF POPULAR DISPLEASURE, IN TIME WILL STEP FORTH FROM ITS SHADOW AS THE BRIGHTER FOR A TEMPORARY OBSCURITY.

I ADMIT THAT I HAVE COVETED "THE HONOR OF BEING USEFUL TO MY COUNTRY," BUT I HAVE SOUGHT TO ATTAIN IT ONLY THROUGH THE PRACTICE OF THE VIRTUES THAT DESERVE IT.

IF I HAD MY HAND UPON MY MOUTH AND IN THE DUST, WHEN I HEARD OF THESE THINGS MY PARTY WOULD HAVE BEEN DOWN THE STAIRS.

AS A PRIVATE CITIZEN, I DO NOT FEEL THAT I AM OBLIGED TO TAKE SUCH ATTENTION TO PUBLIC AFFAIRS AS COMES WITHIN THE DUTY OF EVERY CITIZEN.

I HAVE NEITHER REGRETS NOR APPOLOGIES TO MAKE FOR MY COURSE. NOR SHALL I EVER HOLD OUT MY HAND FOR FEE OR REWARD. I FEEL THAT MY CONDUCT DESERVES THE APPROVAL OF EVERY RIGHT THINKING MAN; CERTAINLY THOSE WHO PAY THE TAXES.

THEY WHO CONSUME THEM, I WELL KNOW WOULD RESENT ANY CHECK UPON THE FACILITIES FOR REACHING THE PUBLIC PURSE.

THERE WILL BE LITTLE HOPE OF CHECKING THE TENDENCY TO EXTRAVAGANCE, CORRUPTION AND THE USELESS MULTIPLICATION OF OFFICES, WHEN IT IS UNDERSTOOD THAT LOYALTY TO THE COMMON GOOD MUST RESULT IN POLITICAL ANNIHILATION.

PART OF THEIR WASTE AND CORRUPT EXTRAVAGANCE WAS DONE UNDER COLOR OF LAW. THIS FACT, IN CONNECTION WITH THE DISPOSITION ON THE PART OF THE PEOPLE TO CONDONE OFFENSES OF THAT KIND, RENDERS A RECOVERY EXTREMELY DOUBTFUL.

THE PEOPLE IN THIS COUNTY KNOW THAT IN ONE THING I HAVE BEEN CONSISTENT; THAT IS, IN MY EFFORTS TO SECURE ECONOMY IN PUBLIC AFFAIRS.

IT WILL BE REMEMBERED THAT WHEN I TOOK CHARGE OF COUNTY AFFAIRS I FOUND THE COUNTY IN DEBT NEAR TWELVE THOUSAND DOLLARS.

SPECULATIONS BROUGHT UP COUNTY WARRANTS AT FROM 80 TO 90 CENTS ON THE DOLLAR.

AFTER MY FIRST YEAR THEY WERE PAID BY THE TREASURER ON PRESENTATION. WHILE THE RATE OF TAXATION WAS LEASOURED, ROADS WERE IMPROVED AND BRIDGES BUILT IN EXTENT BEYOND ALL THAT HAD PREVIOUSLY BEEN DONE FROM THE FIRST ORGANIZATION OF THE COUNTY.

OFFICERS WERE REQUIRED TO DO THEIR DUTY AND TO CONTENT THEMSELVES WITH THEIR LAWFUL FEES. CLERKS AND SHERIFFS STOOD UPON NO FOOTING IN THIS RESPECT THAN ROAD SUPERVISORS AND COUNTY CONSTABLES.

I SUPERVISED THE PUBLIC FUNDS NOR ALLOWED OTHERS TO DO SO. WHEN I BECAME A MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATURE I ENDEAVORED TO PURSUE THE SAME COURSE.

I PUT ASIDE PRIVATE OBLIGATIONS AND THE CLAIMS OF FRIENDSHIP AND ENDEAVORED TO SERVE THE STATE UNBIASED BY FEAR OR ILLEGAL AND WASTEFUL EXPENDITURE OF THE PUBLIC MONEY THAT TO EXPOSE AND IF POSSIBLE PURSUE SUCH ACTS ON THE PART OF THOSE WHO WERE JUST VANDALIZING THE PRINCIPAL STATE OFFICES.

THE SUPREME COURT RECENTLY DECIDED THAT ALL ALLOWANCES FOR MILEAGE TO SHERIFFS FOR CONVEYING CONVICTS TO THE PENITENTIARY AND PATIENTS TO THE ASYLUM SINCE 1874, WERE ILLEGAL.

INDEED THERE WAS NEVER A QUESTION ABOUT IT. YET MR. CHADWICK'S ALLOWANCES UNDER THAT HEAD AMOUNT TO NEAR \$30,000.

IN MANY INSTANCES SHERIFFS RECEIVED OVER \$30 PER DAY AND EXPENSES, WHEN THEY WERE LAWFULLY ENTITLED TO THEM. THE COST OF KEEPING PRISONERS IN THE PENITENTIARY UNDER GROVER AND CHADWICK WAS FROM SIX TO EIGHT DOLLARS PER WEEK FOR EACH CONVICT.

THE COST OF CONFINING EACH CONVICT FOR EACH YEAR WAS ABOUT \$1,000. IT IS NOW ABOUT \$13,000. WHERE FROM TWELVE TO TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS ARE PAID OUT FOR JERICAL AID IN THE LAND DEPARTMENT BUSINESS.

WHICH \$210 IS NOW PAID, WHICH BUT RECORDS ARE KEPT AND A GREATER AMOUNT OF LABOR PERFORMED. THERE ARE OTHER MATTERS WHERE THE CONTRACT IS EQUALLY GREAT.

IT IS TRUE THAT THE PRESENT STATE OFFICERS HAVE SHOWN A WISE AND LAUDIBLE ECONOMY IN PUBLIC EXPENDITURES, BUT THE LESSON THEY HAVE HAD WOULD RESTRAIN THEM FROM THE WASTEFUL COURSE OF THEIR PREDECESSORS.

THEY WERE OTHERWISE INDULGED. I HAVE HAD TOO MUCH CONTENTMENT FOR MY ASSAILANTS TO ANSWER THEIR CHARGES, FEELING SURE IN THE CONSCIOUSNESS OF HAVING DONE SIMPLY A DUTY, AND IN THE CONVICTION THAT TIME WOULD VINDICATE MY ACTION AND ESTABLISH MY MOTIVES.

WHATSOEVER THE POPULAR JUDGMENT MIGHT BE I HAD DIVESTED MYSELF OF EVERY SELFISH PURPOSE AND FOLLOWED DUTY AS MY JUDGMENT INDICATED ME. THEY DEEM THAT I AM PLAYING THE DEMAGOGUE FOR SOME END; THAT THERE IS SOME SORT OF BARGAIN WITH THE SO-CALLED BUSH RING.

THEY WOULD SAY THIS WHETHER THEY BELIEVED IT OR NOT. IT IS EVEN PROBABLE THAT THEY DO BELIEVE IT. MEN WHO HAVE NEVER ACTED FROM UNSELFISH MOTIVES OR FELT A GENEROUS IMPULSE WOULD HARDLY CREDIT THEIR EXISTENCE IN OTHERS.

USUALLY MEN JUDGE OTHERS FROM THEMSELVES. ACCUSTOMED TO ACCOMPLISH THEIR ENDS THROUGH BARGAINING AND CORRUPT COMBINATIONS INTRIGUE, AND THE THOUSAND SHIFTS THAT CUNNING RESORTS TO, IT IS INCALCULABLE TO THEM THAT ANY ONE SHOULD ACT FROM A SENSE OF DUTY, OR SEEK SUCCESS THROUGH AN OPEN WAY.

THEY CANNOT UNDERSTAND THAT SUCCESS SHOULD COME OF MERIT, OR THAT A MAN SHOULD DO AN HONEST DEED OTHER THAN FOR EFFECT.

MY DEMOCRACY, SO FAR AS PRINCIPLE IS CONCERNED, HAS BEEN "WITHOUT VARIATION OR THE SHADOW OF TURNING." I PROFESS ALIQUOTAGE TO NO MAN OR SET OF MEN.

IF DEMOCRACY CONSISTS IN FOLLOWING THE LEAD OF POLITICAL LEADERS, I HAVE MISTAKEN ITS PURPOSE, AND HERE TAKE OCCASION TO ADJURE AND REPUDIATE SUCH DEMOCRACY. I SHALL EVER TAKE THE PRIVILEGE OF EXPOSING THE DELINQUENCIES AND THE MISDEEDS OF THOSE IN PUBLIC POSITION WHEN THEY COME TO MY KNOWLEDGE.

MORE ESPECIALLY WHEN THEY ARE COMMITTED BY MEN OF MY OWN PARTY FOR WHOM ACTS I FEEL A MORE IMMEDIATE RESPONSIBILITY. MANY SEEM TO THINK THAT IT IS TREASON TO THE PARTY TO EXPOSE THE MALFEASANCE OF DEMOCRATIC OFFICIALS. I NEVER PROFESSIONED ALIQUOTAGE TO ANY SUCH DOGMA, NOR DO I BELONG TO A PARTY HOLDING ANY SUCH CREED.

I DO NOT BELONG TO ANY TEMPERANCE SOCIETY. ON ONE OCCASION I ADDRESSED THE BLUE RIBBON CLUB OF THIS PLACE AT THEIR INVITATION. BUT THAT ADDRESS WAS CHARACTERIZED BY NO INTEMPERATE ZEAL. MY EFFORTS IN BEHALF OF TEMPERANCE HAVE BEEN CONFINED MAINLY TO LIVING TEMPERATE AND SOBERLY. I SHOULD BE SORRY TO WIN THE FAVOR OF THOSE WHO MAKE THAT A CAUSE OF OFFENSE. TRULY YOURS, J. M.
