**T**HIS first class will be admitted to enter upon the regular course of study in this Institution on the 2d Wednesday in September next, when the collegiate year will hereafter commence.

A Library of 1000 vols. and philosophical apparatus are for the use and benefit of scholars. Candidates for admission must possess a knowledge of the usual branches of a common English education—the elements of Algebra to Equations, and must pass a satisfactory examination in the Latin language upon a portion of Caesar's Commentaries, and four orations of Cicero; and, in Greek, upon the 1st book of Xenophon's Anabasis, or their equivalents.

A preparatory department is under the direction of J. M. Kehler, Principal of Tualatin Academy. (See advertisement.)
