NOTICE TO SETTLERS.

The Surveyor General of Oregon will issue to all settlers "Notices" of donation claims, from and after the 1st day of December next. After which time, on and after the 1st day of December, all applications for the entry of land claims, as well as for Pre-emption rights, and the evidences of the rights of orphans, under the last amendment of the donation laws, have to be made direct to the Register and Receiver of the Oregon land district at Oregon City. All entries of claims, which have not been adjudicated by the Surveyor General, before the 1st of December next, will be transferred to the said Register and Receiver in conformity with instructions from the Commissioners of the General Land Office, and in pursuance of the Act of Congress, approved July 17, 1854, amendatory of the Donation Laws.
