Whiteaker vs. Brents. The average Republican politician in Oregon today are howling themselves hoarse about Whiteaker. They say he is doing nothing and now I suppose they will grow wonderfully for Tom Brents, the Republican representative from Washington Territory, who is certainly the peer of Mr. George, who has been at work and is making his mark in Congress, as will be seen by the following telegram, we suppose sent by the associate press as Republican electioneering document.

Yesterday Justice Harris decided the case of Brents against Keenan in favor of the defendant. The plaintiff is a candidate in Congress from Washington Territory, and brought a suit of damages from the defendant for \$15,000.
