NEW YORK, July 30.—The following is Gen. Hancock's letter of acceptance: GOVERNOR'S ISSUING, N. Y. CITY, July 29, 1880.

GENTLEMEN—I have the honor to acknowledge receipt of your letter of July 13, 1880, apprising me of your nomination to the office of president of the United States...

The 13th, 14th and 15th amendments to the constitution of the United States embracing the result of the war for the Union are irrevocable. It called to the presidency I should deem it my duty to resist with all my power any attempt to impair or evade the full force and effect of the constitution...
