TO BEGIN BUILDING FOR HIGHER VALUES

COUNTY COURT ACCEPTS PLAN OF DENNIS NICHOLS.

Dwelling and Hospital Will be Built at Once on the County Farm on McKay Creek.

The county court yesterday accepted the plan of Dennis Nichols for the dwelling and hospital at the poor farm.

Mr. Nichols will be employed by the board to oversee the construction of the buildings.

All the labor-skilled and otherwise will be hired by the day, the board believing that the most economical method as well as the best from the standpoint of excellence of work.

Bids Taken Wednesday. The board adjourned last evening until Wednesday next when bids for the dwelling and hospital will be opened.

The buildings are to be built by the farm and will be located close to the eastern boundary of the farm.
