UMATILLA COUNTY DEBT STEADILY DECREASING.

Interesting Statement Compiled From the Official Records—Liabilities Have Been Reduced About Sixty-Two Thousand Dollars in Three Years.

For some time the county clerk's office has been busy preparing the accounts and auditing the items of the various departments of the county business preparatory to closing the books for the end of the fiscal year.

By the last report the total of the county debt is \$63,324.74. This is the county debt as of January 1, 1932. It was \$102,103.93 on January 1, 1931, and \$108,975.87 on January 1, 1930.
