



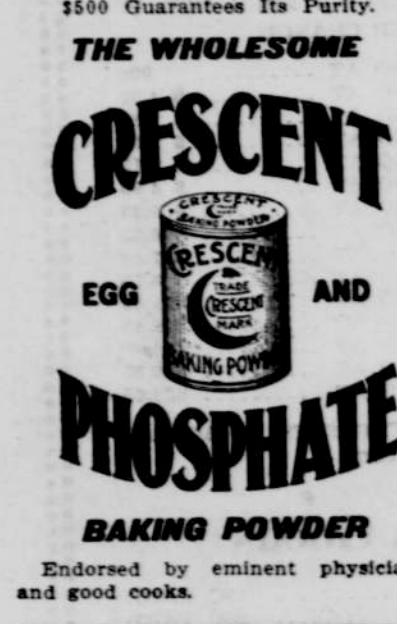

It is then graduated and placed in amounts and 1000 units each into hermetically sealed glass syringes. One thousand units is considered sufficient to immunize a person, although as high as 50,000 units have been injected into a single patient. I have used up 18,000 units on one little girl at the school.
