The Grand Lodge I. O. O. F., of Oregon convened at Odd Fellows' Temple, in this city, on Tuesday morning. About one hundred members were present. The annual address of the Grand Master contained the following statistics: There are fifty-three lodges in this State, six in Washington Territory, six in Idaho, and nine in the Oregon lodges in the jurisdiction. The growth of the lodges and the welfare of the Order is illustrated in the facts that the total membership numbers 2,800 persons, and the gross receipts of the lodges for the year just past by the handsome amount of \$20,000. Eight thousand six hundred and sixty-eight dollars of this amount have been paid out for the relief of sick brethren, \$1,500 for the relief of widows and orphans of deceased brethren, and \$2,000 for funeral expenses and the education of orphans. Within the last twelve months there have also been 325 new members initiated, and the number admitted by card footed up 120 more, making the total number of ac-commodations since the period mentioned, 432. Five new Lodges have been organized, and there has been \$1,400 paid by the Widows and Orphan's Relief Association to widows of deceased brethren—an organization working under the auspices of the Grand Lodge.

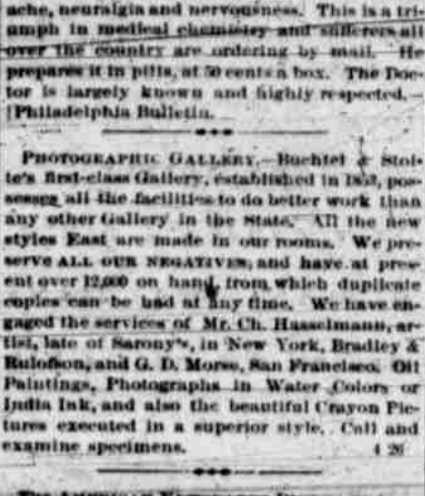
