The English authorities are kept busy capturing arms in transit to Ireland.

Lima, Peru, is said to be well defended against the Chilean forces, and a desperate battle is anticipated.

President Anderwer of the Swiss Confederation committed suicide on the 27th instant, probably while temporarily insane.

On the 23d instant, a party of Boers of South Africa attacked and overpowered 250 men of the ninety-fourth British regiment, killing nearly half of them and taking the rest prisoners.

The Irish State trial of agitators, or traversers, was commenced in Dublin on Tuesday before the Court of the Queen's Bench.

The Transvaal (South Africa) Republic has published a decree declaring that the Government has no desire to spill blood and no wish for war, but is anxious to join in everything leading to progress.
