

HOSTILITY TO BINGER.

Under the above head the Oregonian of Monday the 13th, says:

"If the sentiment expressed in portions of Douglas county can be taken as index of the feelings throughout the first congressional district, Binger Hermann will have a hard time to secure a re-nomination to congress." And further says: "There is an under current of feeling hostile to Hermann on account of his failure, in part, to secure the chairmanship of the rivers and harbor committee, and in part to his attitude on the free silver question."
