NEW ORLEANS, April 13.—The Picayune tomorrow will print the following letter, dated April 5, from its special correspondent at Havana:

The condition of affairs is continuing to draw to a crisis, and soon there will be a clash which will either redound to the benefit of the Spaniards or the Cubans.

Big bulky pills were in general use. Like the "blunderbuss" of that decade they were big and clumsy, but ineffective.

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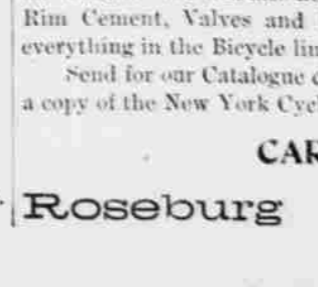
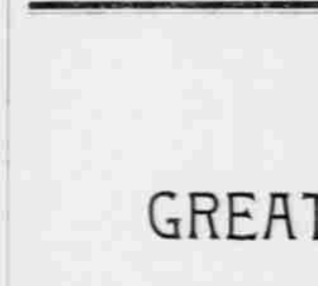
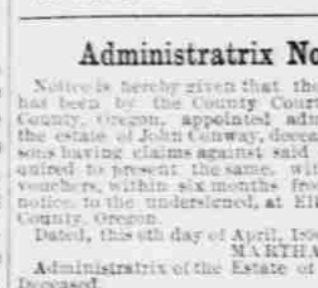
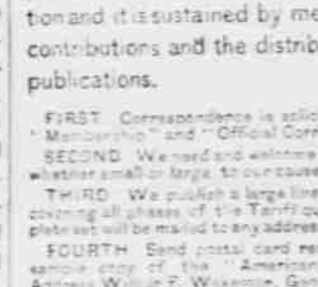
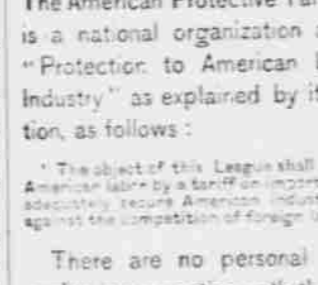
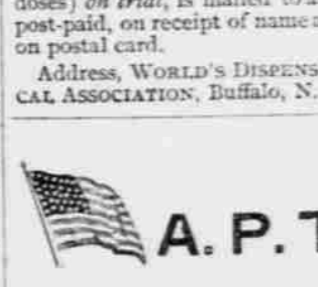
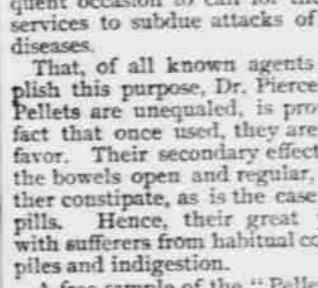
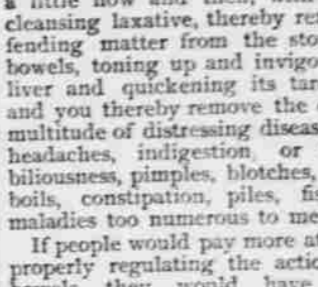
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
