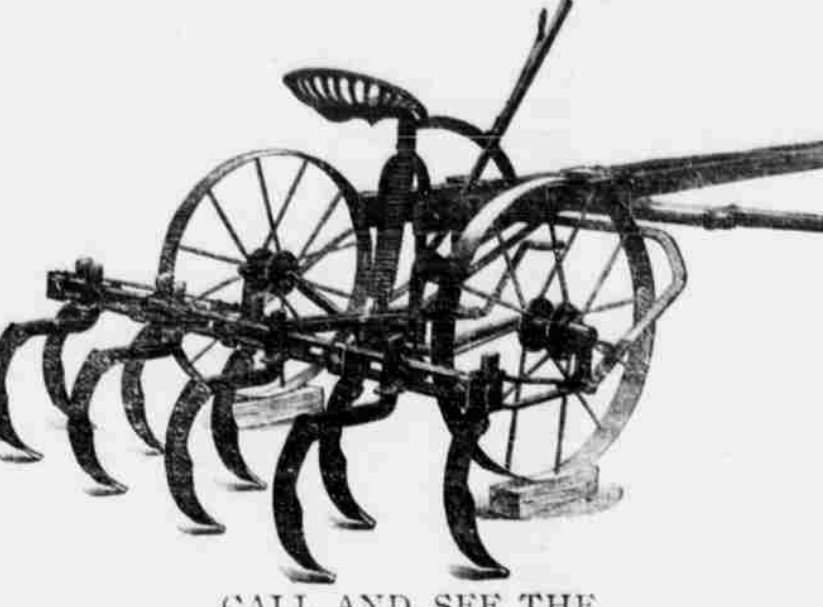
For School Teachers to Paste in Their Hats.
