THE CLONDYKE MINES.

California and Australia Repeated. It would appear that in the gold placers recently discovered along Bonanza and Eldorado creeks, in the Clonduke district of the Yukon, the world is to witness a repetition of the great mining excitement of California and Australia. Possibly not in point of numbers of men rushing to the diggings but in the wonderful richness of the placers.

James McKay, J. S. Macaulay and Richard Butler, men of known responsibility, have returned from the new gold fields and confirm in every manner the rumors concerning the wonderful richness of the Clonduke that have heretofore reached the outside world.

An example of the fabulous wealth of the country, says the Alaska Mining Record, is shown in the product of one pan of dirt washed out on an Eldorado claim, the dust being brought out by Mr. Macaulay and placed on exhibition at the "Occidental" hotel in this city, which at 8 1/2 an ounce weighs \$243.

Coming as this does, direct from the scene, brought by a well-known, responsible and reliable gentleman whose statements are backed by those of a dozen different parties of known integrity, leaves no doubt as to truthfulness of the statements made.

Again the warning is sent out to all to stay out of the Yukon country unless abundant supplies are taken. There will be work for a large number of men and wages will not be less than \$10 a day, but all men hired will be required to board themselves, and it is more than likely that those who come with less than a year's supplies will be refused work. If a claimowner employs a man who comes without provisions, he forces a division of his own scanty stores, and thus cutting his own throat and insuring the doubling of his own privations. The companies cannot possibly carry in enough to supply those already there; any addition to the number to be provided for must bring starvation to all.

Mr. Butler of this party, is interested in claims 23 and 24 above and 98 below discovery on Bonanza creek and also on Bear Creek, and has wintered in that district. He is on his way to visit his former home in the western Minnesota, and will return next month to his claims, taking in a large quantity of supplies. He tells us that during the winter he offered as high as \$25 for a shovel, in fact, for any old thing which would answer the purpose of a shovel, but could not procure the article. Pans are equally in demand and equally scarce.

Concerning the big returns from single pans of dirt, it should be remembered that the dirt is invariably taken from the bedrock and in these instances rich spots the paystreak is always thin, sometimes not more than two or three inches. On the other hand, an example is found in the Rhodius claim where the gravel runs from \$2.47 to the pan on the upper strata of the bedrock, with a paystreak nine feet deep. In such claims as this no barren dirt need be handled and the net profits equal those where the richer though very much smaller paystreaks are found.
